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Board Meeting Minutes of June 30, 2026

1. Agenda approval was presented on a motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Olsen. The motion passed with all in favor.

2. Approval of the Board Meeting Minutes of May 26, 2026 were reviewed and approved. On a motion made by Rutherglen and seconded by Crabtree to approve the minutes as presented. The motion passed with all in favor.

6. The Board Discussed paying the CalPERS UAL in full to save on interest and monthly invoice fees from Kampschmidt Payroll and Accounting Services. On a motion made by Rutherglen to pay the UAL in full 1 lump sum to save on cost. The motion was seconded by Olsen. The motion passed with all in favor.

7. The Board and staff reviewed and discussed some informational literature that was included in the Board packets that talked about Sterile Insect Technique and the Experimental Use Permits required. To release Sterile Mosquitoes.

8. *The District update was given by Nunes, Nunes talked to the Board about Light trap numbers and how the District was going to transition from fogging hot spots to full scheduled routes throughout the county Monday July 6, 2026. He also informed the Board that Willows and Orland would be fogged for the 4th of July. Mallory asked how the mosquito fish were doing and Nunes reported that the fish population at Mansville was booming.*
